2024 was an incredible year!

Our impact grew by 25% and we brought the healing power of art to 5,006 children and their families.

We learned a lot about engaging with our community and working together to deliver our mission. It's humbling to see volunteers, sponsors, and organizations come together to support the children and families we serve.

Our strategy was to strengthen our operations, develop how organizations can get involved, and ultimately bring the healing power of art to more children than the prior year.

CHILDHOOD CANCER AN ALL TOO COMMON DISEASE

Every year an estimated 15,780 children between birth and 19 years of age are diagnosed with cancer.

Approximately 1 in 285 children in the U.S. will be diagnosed with cancer before their 20th birthday.

Cancer isn't the only threat to a child's health.

That is one of the reasons our program includes all children battling for their health due to a serious illness.

I spent a lot of time thinking about what I wanted to do, and in one moment it clicked. Make it big, so big it scares me.

One day I received a watercolor kit my mom and sister sent me in the mail. I was going through chemo and burning out on watching TV. It was those moments of painting, I felt something. I felt empowered, productive and happy.

During chemo I thought a lot about how I wanted to give back. I wanted to create something that would outlive me. I wanted to help people come back from tragedy with confidence. I wanted people to know that creativity, self-expression, and experiencing joy, heals. I wanted to inspire and empower with kindness. I knew I wanted to bring what I saw in art to others.

I was 28 years old when I was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma, which is a cancer commonly diagnosed in children. I imagined kids going through what I went through. I felt the fear, the loneliness, the curiosity, and the uncontrollable emotions before, during, and after every treatment. I thought about their parents, their siblings and friends, I envisioned what we are doing today, bringing the healing power of art to children so they can be kids, while they are in the hospital.

ART PROGRAM

The Creations for Cures Art Program gives kids time to get creative and have a moment of escape during the challenges they face while receiving treatments in the hospital, stuck in a hospital bed, or away from the comforts of home.

Volunteers host fun and engaging art projects for the kids and their families.

Our goal is to reach as many kids and their families as possible with the Art Program. We continue to expand to hospitals across the country, aiding children in the fight to defeat childhood cancer and serious illness.



STEP ONE!

CFC Volunteers create custom art projects, each month. They film videos for the Virtual Art Hour and they work with children's hospitals to stream Art Hour to the patient's rooms.





STEP TWO!

Next, the CFC Team builds a custom quantity of art kits for every hospital and Ronald McDonald House we serve!

STEP THREE!

The CFC Art Team visits the hospital and Ronald McDonald Home and does art with children and their families, in person...



STEP FOUR!

Or we deliver Art Hour Virtually!








Our art kits inspire creativity and empower children to express themselves. They are filled with a variety of supplies, including different projects every month.





